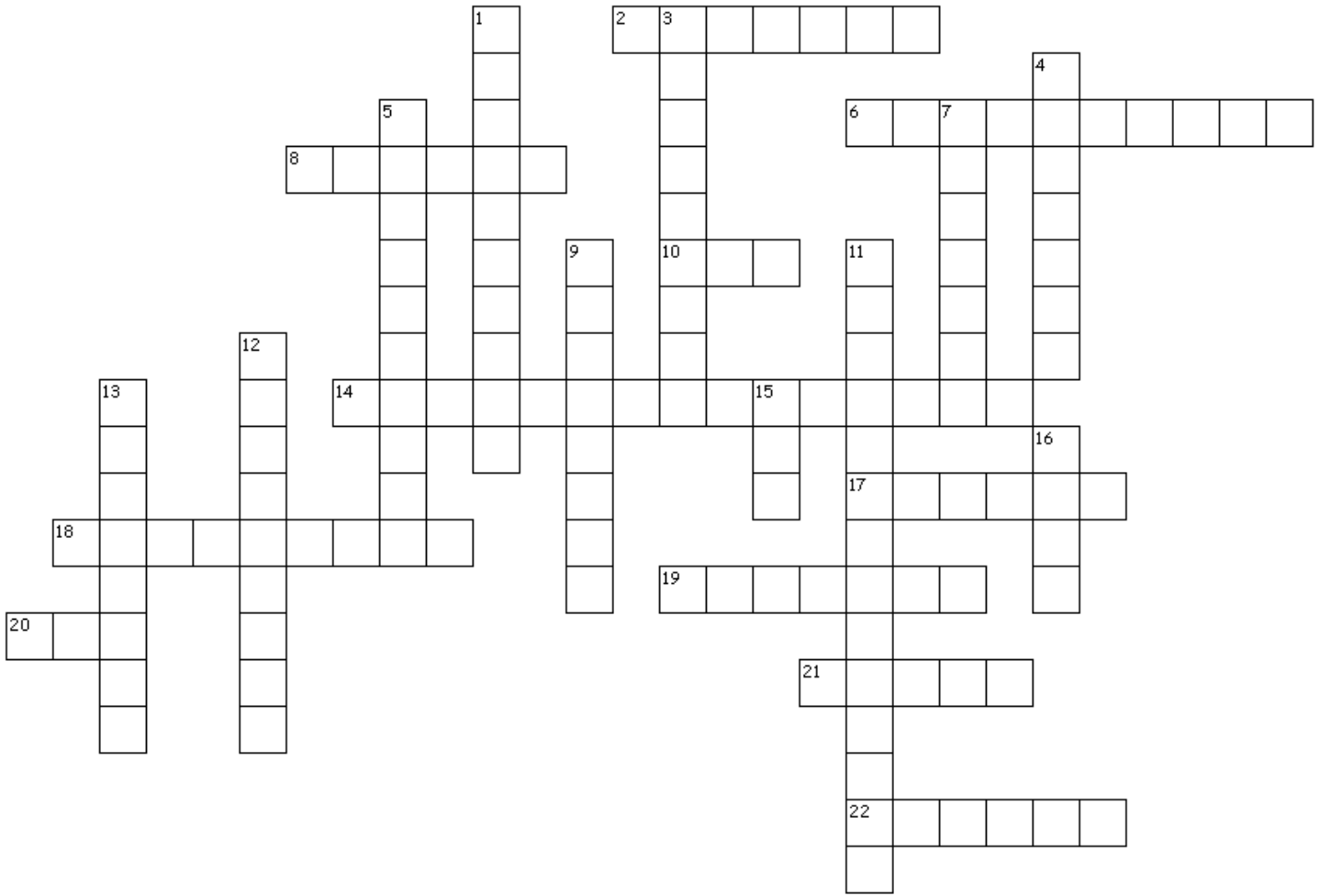


CROSSWORD PUZZLE



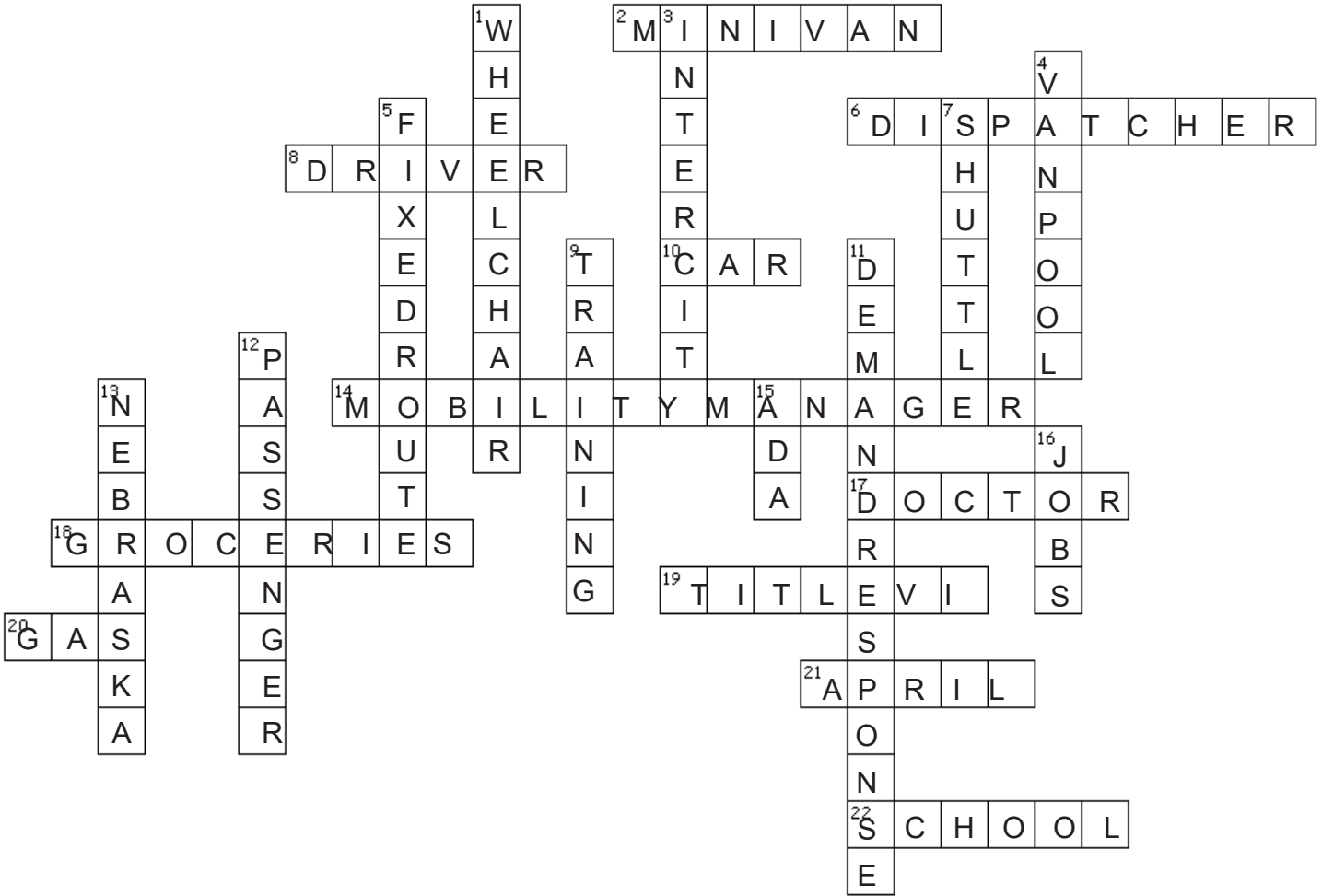
